A big thank you goes to Hon. Jean Augustine who provided sessions of coaching and mentoring to help improve professional growth.


OGAV SUPPORT AND PROMOTE ADVANCEMENT OF GIRLS EDUCATION

Developed and improved Program quality

1. Co-curricular School Program (Girls Club)

- We promote and advance girl's education through "Empowerment Learning series "Initiative" for girls and young women
- The Girl's club is a socio-academic club that is student-centred and focused. It gives an impactful experience for a positive outcome
- We were able to reach out to more girls, about 30 young girls through our events, hopefully, we would be able to consolidate our efforts and have a consistent relationship to help establish a monthly program in the coming year

2. Summer Leadership Camp (STEM)

This is a program that runs during the summer holiday for four weeks and it is geared towards the following objectives:

- Girls and women have for far too long been underrepresented and undervalued in both STEM careers and educational settings. By participating in practical and fun engineering, programming, and scientific activities from an early age, girls can get a clearer understanding of what they could do as an engineer or programmer.
- Girls acquire the broad range of academic, social and emotional skills to equip them for success.
- Have structured opportunities for enriching experiences in a safe environment.
- Improving learning that leads to academic success, helps them become lifelong learner as an adult and foster better social life.





3. Scholarship Scheme

Our aim is to enhance the girls learning, support economically disadvantaged public secondary school girls financially through bursary and scholarship toward post-secondary destination

The support is given to students who have demonstrated financial need and can provide evidence of volunteerism/leadership within the community.

Secondary school girls benefit from our programs and service to empower them build a better life for themselves.

Launched new initiatives and outreach events

Thanks to the generosity of our supporters and the efforts of the Trustees. It was a year of restructuring more than celebration.

First annual Spring Event - Mother/Daughter Breakfast

Mother Daughter Event held in March to commemorate the International Women's Day with the goals of:

- A. Reaching more youth to gain a better understanding of how to meet their needs and foster a good relationship at home
- B. Building relationships to foster better academic achievements and social skills with the girls
- C. For OGAV to be effective we need to start where it is most important, that is home. Statistically, it has been proven that girls succeed and thrive when they have good support at home.

A celebration of a Trustee that exemplifies selflessness and commitment over and above call of duty. The recipient for 2019 was Mrs. Judith Olomodosi.


Connect
